STOP DOG ROAMING

Roaming dogs are detrimental in controlling the dog population, they increase the spread of parasites and disease and can cause car accidents.



Keep your dogs safe in an enclosed garden, yard or crate. Don't leave them for too long and always ensure they have shelter and water.

Don't allow your dog to roam onto others' land or property. Also don't allow other dogs onto yours.





Walk your dog on a lead at least once a day when it is cooler. Only go off lead if your dog comes back when called and there is no traffic around.

Preventing dog roaming improves the status, cleanliness and hygiene of your community. It makes it a safer place for dogs and people.



Be a responsible dog owner, spay your dog and refrain from allowing it to roam.
